# Curriculum Snapshot – Summer 1 Term 2025

## English

In English we will start by reading the picture book: The Matchbox Diary. This tells the story of a boy who leaves Europe to travel across the Atlantic to a new life in America. We will use the images to write poems based on a storm in the Atlantic.

We will then research and write a nonchronological report of the Statue of Liberty in New York. We will learn about the history, symbolism and importance of this important monument.

Finally, we will be writing a historical recount using the book: The Man who walked between the Towers. This tells the story of Phillipe Petit and his dream to walk on tightrope between the Twin Towers in New York.

#### Maths

Weekly arithmetic tests will continue in the Summer Term in preparation for the transition to Year 6.

This half term we will be learning about regular and irregular shapes. We will be classifying triangles and learning to estimate and measure angles using a protractor. We will then use the protractor to draw angles accurately.

We will then look at symmetry and translation of shapes before moving onto work around reading and plotting coordinates in all 4 quadrants.

We will then move onto written and mental methods for adding and subtracting decimal numbers.

Science Life Cycles – Animals Children will learn about the similarities and differences between the life cycles of insects, amphibians, mammals and birds. We will look at the changes humans undergo in their life cycles and focus on the changes adolescents experience during puberty.
