We are really excited to have secured a residential booking at the **Pioneer Centre, Cleobury Mortimer**, beautifully situated on the edge of the Wyre Forest in Shropshire for a joint Years 5 and 6 School Journey from Wednesday 5th October or Friday 7th October.

The Centre offers a set adventure programme, which will mean that the children will be busy from the time they arrive to the time they leave and will include extensive adventurous activities that offer the children the opportunity to stretch themselves as individuals, bond as a team and grow in friendship as they work together, eat together and relax together. The cost of this residential will be £258.00. This includes the transport, accommodation, food and the cost of the activities. The cost for the children who are on the Pupil Premium Grant list will be at the reduced price of £129. Your place on the trip will be reserved upon receipt of a non-refundable £40 deposit by Tuesday 14th June.. If we reach our maximum number, you can ask to be placed on a waiting list. Should we not have enough interest in the trip, we will have to cancel and your deposits will be refunded.
