Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of a unit of work on Hinduism, Year 6 will be visiting Kenton Temple (Shree Kutch Satsang Swaminarayan Temple) on Wednesday 22nd November. The children will be out of school for the whole morning. We aim to return by 12:30pm where the children will have lunch as normal.

We will leave at 10:00am and walk to Kenton Temple (approximately 20 minutes). As such, please consider the weather on that day and make sure that your child has a suitable coat and appropriate footwear. School uniform must be worn on the visit. Upon entry, the children will be asked to remove their shoes which will then be stored in a reserved holding area. Please ensure that the children are wearing socks so that they can wear these when looking around the temple.

Please be aware that the children will not be taking part in any worship, but learning about:

- Why the environment is important to Hindus
- The history of the Mandir
- The history of Hinduism

The school considers this activity particularly important as it will enhance the learning that has been taking place in school. This will give the children first-hand experience of a place of worship which may be different to their own.
