

# ART ATTACK



During the Autumn term, Elmgrove ran its Art Attack club, which has now been established for two years. In the club, children learned how to create tessellations inspired by stained-glass windows, as well as how to produce observational drawings. They then transferred their sketches onto canvas using lead paper before painting with acrylics. Throughout the process, pupils developed skills in light and dark shading, colour mixing, brush strokes, understanding bristle density, layering techniques, wetting the canvas with a subtle base colour for a backdrop, and adding fine details to complete their work.
